



To help our campers develop a deeper connection to nature, campers will spend over half of their day outside (weather permitting). This will include planned activities as well as unstructured play time with plenty of materials to engage with on Museum grounds and adjacent Park District land.

While each day (and age group) is unique, here is an example of a day in the life of a 5 to 6 year-old camper:

Time	Activity
8:45 – 9:15	Camper drop-off
9:15 – 10:10	Indoor Activities- like art or group games
10:10 – 10:15	Bathroom break
10:15 – 11:15	Outdoor Exploration - like a trail hike or habitat exploration
11:15 – 11:30	Bathroom break
11:30 – 12:00	Lunch
12:00 – 12:45	Outdoor play - child- led nature play
12:45 – 1:00	Bathroom
1:00 – 1:30	Snack
1:30 – 2:30	Outdoor Exploration - like a group challenges or scavenger hunts
2:30 – 2:45	Prep for pick-up
2:45 – 3:15	Camper pick-up
