**Acquisition Information:** The original acquisition of this collection is unknown. Some parts of the collection, including some or possibly all of the glass-plate negatives, were given to us through the Morton Arboretum (see correspondence from 1983 in Series 5: Sub-series 3). The Academy's collections also include specimens donated by Gault between 1896 and 1905.

**Processor and Date:** Glenn Oba and Amber K. King, May, August, October 2010. Updated August 2014, A. King.

**Processing Note:** Dates are not all inclusive. Organization not based on original order as documents moved repeatedly before final processing.

A small amount of the written material by Gault, comprising handwritten notes, has been transcribed. Original negatives to the photos within the photograph album of Robert Ridgway photographs from a survey of the lower Wabash River valley are currently housed in the Illinois State Museum's collection. Copies of these negatives were made for the Academy May 20, 1980 at the request of then Director, Dr. William Beecher. These negatives are stored with the photograph album so their association is not lost.

**Biographical Sketch:** Benjamin T. Gault (ca.1859 -1942) was born in New Hampshire but moved to Glen Ellyn, Illinois in 1890 with his mother. He moved his already large personal specimen collection with him to Illinois. He then continued building his collection of birds and mammals, as well as his reputation as a naturalist and conservationist. He collected and made observations locally, domestically throughout the United States, and abroad traveling to Cayenne (French Guiana) in South America and to various islands in Ireland.

He was extremely active in the birding community and published a Checklist of Illinois Birds in 1922 through the Illinois Audubon Society. He was assisted in this by many other respected naturalists of the time, including Robert Ridgway and E.R. Ford. In addition he utilized his copious migratory notes in developing the list.

Upon his death, his vast, and meticulously documented, collection remained in storage at the friend's home, the Wagoner's, with whom he lived during the latter portion of his life. It was not moved from this location until 1964, when a daughter of the family donated the entire collection to the Morton Arboretum and the Field Museum. Locally his efforts have been memorialized through the establishment of the Benjamin Gault Wildlife Bird Sanctuary as a part of the Glen Ellyn Park District.

**Scope and Content:** The materials found within this collection are most heavily focused on Gault's interests in Ornithology. Much of the information consists of bird lists, bird migration notes, or notes and writings on birds and his observations. Many of the handwritten notes are incomplete or there are 2 or more copies of the same notes at various lengths, all in Gault's hand. The photographs and negatives are all related to his various collection efforts.

#### **Series Description:**

##### **Series 1: Personal (1883-1943, undated)**

This series contains correspondence between Gault and various other people, particularly George K. Cherrie and Mr. Oldfield Thomas, as well as general notes, notes on printed articles and publications, and handwritten copies of articles and lectures written by Gault. His lecture notes range from papers presented to the Ridgway Ornithological Club to students. It is divided into five sub-series: Correspondence, Diaries, General Notes/Notebooks, and Lectures/Writings. All the materials found in the Lectures/Writings sub-series have been transcribed and are available by contacting the Collections department.

**Series 2: Printed Materials (1855-1934, undated)**

This series contains materials related to printed publications. It contains publications that Gault wrote, commented on or that were found in the collection. It also contains copies of pages from the proofs for a bird lists printed by the Illinois Audubon Society on the Birds of Illinois.

**Series 3: Botany (undated)**

This is a small series outlining notes on botany specimens collected by or researched by Gault. It also contains handwritten lists of specimens collected by Gault and then given/ exchanged/ or transferred to other collectors or institutions.

**Series 4: Mammalogy (1893, undated)**

This small series contains information on mammal specimens collected by Gault, notes on birds and mammals in the Chicago wilderness area, and a drawing of an antelope head collected in 1893 that corresponds to small samples within the Chicago Academy of Sciences mammalogy collection.

**Series 5: Bird Notes (1870-1983, undated)**

This is the largest series in the collection. It contains handwritten notes on birds found in certain areas, bird migration notes from the Chicago Wilderness region, specimen notes from birds collected by Gault, and notes of birds that Gault gave/ transferred/ or exchanged with other collectors and institutions. It also has collection records for birds observed and collected in the Chicago Wilderness area, other areas of the United States, and two locations abroad, namely Cayenne and Ireland. This series contains three sub-series: DuPage County, Illinois, Illinois, and United States and Abroad.

**Series 6: Photographs (1875-1916, undated) (stored separately, RVWD.302 Film Room.Unit 1.I)**

This series contains photographic prints made by or owned by B.T. Gault. It is divided into three sub-series: Identified, Unidentified, and Other Photographers. The identified photographic prints are of collecting trips he made into Otter Tail and Aitken County, Minnesota. There are some photographs from fellow ornithologist G.A. Abbott. Within "Other Photographers" is an album of photographs taken by Robert Ridgway in the late 1800s along the lower Wabash River visually noting changes to the natural landscape due to agricultural development.

**Series 7: Glass Plate Negatives (1900-1914, undated) (stored separately, RVWD.302 Film Room.Unit 5.B)**

This series contains glass plate negatives made by or owned by B.T. Gault. This series is divided into the following sub-series: 5x7" Plates, 8x10" Plates, and 4 x 5" Plates. The 5x7" plates are made up of images from his trip to French Guiana which he made with George K. Cherrie, records from his local bird watching and collecting trips, images of plants, particularly a Hawthorn (*Crataegus gaultii*), and a few portraits. The 8x10" plates are close-up botanical images. The 4x5" plates contain images from the trip to French Guiana and a large series of images of tree trunks. All the original paper envelopes for the glass plates are stored separately and organized by overall subject, e.g. French Guiana trip, then in chronological order.

**Series 8: Glass Plate Transparencies (undated) (glass plates stored separately, RVWD.302.Film Room.Unit 5.C)**

This series contains glass plate transparencies made by or owned by B.T. Gault. It consists of 8x10" black and white glass plates of botanical specimens and one 8x10" hand-painted lantern slide. Box 4 contains the paper wrappers found with the glass plates that were removed when the collection was re-housed.
