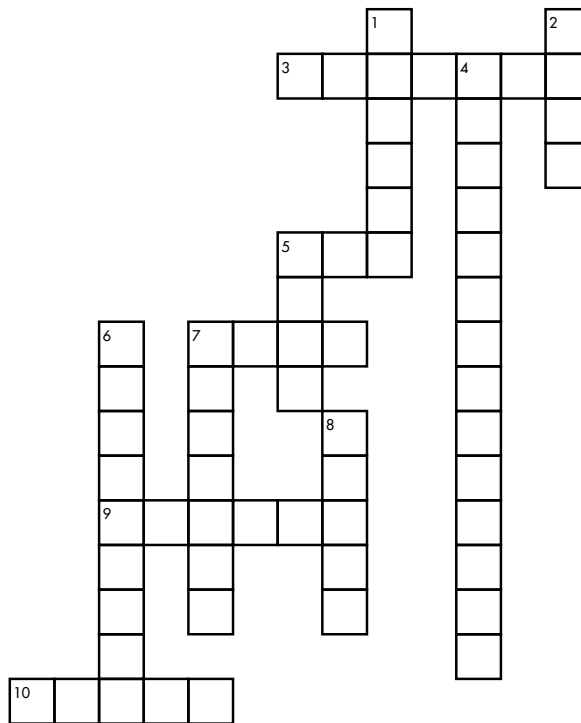


Bison Day Crossword Puzzle



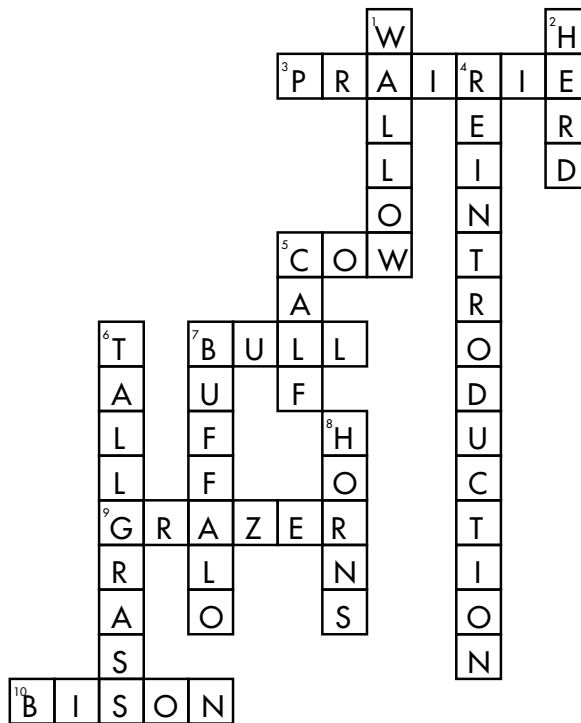
Down:
